### PRESCHOOL AND KINDERS GENERAL INFO

Procedures for Preschool and Circus Kinders students are different than for students in the youth program. Please read the following instructions carefully to be sure you and your student are prepared!

### **EXTRA PRACTICES**

- Preschool and Kinder performers will have one extra practice toward the end of spring session. This rehearsal allows the students to practice in center arena with their full show team.
- See the extra practice schedule <u>posted on the Family Portal</u>: <u>Spring Show Announcements</u>.
- Please note that your student's extra practice might be at a different day and time than their weekly class. If it is at a different time, students should also attend their regular class that week.

### **COSTUMES**

- Preschool and Kinder costumes are distributed and taken home the last week of spring session classes.
- Students should arrive for tech rehearsal and performances dressed in costume.
- Before checking in for each performance, parents will make sure students are fully dressed in their costume, shoes, and accessories.
- Preschool and Kinder performers are not allowed to take anything with them backstage.

### **SHOES**

- All Preschool and Kinder students will need to purchase shoes for their costume.
- Shoes need to be purchased by families and are not included with the student's costume.
- Please refer to the Shoe Flyer on our <u>website</u> for shoe type and color.
- CJ has a long partnership with Grand Jete on Grand Ave. in St. Paul! If you purchase your shoes from Grand Jete before April 1, you will receive a 10% discount. Refer to the shoe flyer for more details!

### HAIR AND MAKEUP

- Please arrive to tech/dress rehearsal and all performances with hair done.
- Long hair should be pulled up off the face and well secured. Ponytails and braids work well.
- Preschool and Kinder performers should NOT wear makeup.

### **MASKS**

- Currently, we will not require masks backstage or during performances. We will continue to monitor the situation and will comply with any mandates that may be in place at the time. Families will be notified immediately if any changes are made to the policy.
- All students are welcome to wear masks backstage or during performances if they wish. If a student wishes to wear a mask for the performance, they can choose a white or black mask. Sparkles are encouraged!

# TECH/DRESS REHEARSAL

- Arrival time for tech/dress rehearsal is 4:00 p.m.
- Preschool and Kinder performers should arrive in costume.
- Parents/guardians and students should sit the south side of the bleachers and should stay in the arena until their student is dismissed.
- A short meeting will be led by the directors and then rehearsal will begin.
- Preschool and/or Kinders will be the first act of the show and will rehearse first
- Performers are dismissed by their coaches when their acts have finished rehearsing.

# SHOW DAY PROCEDURES

#### **Arrival Time for Preschool and Kinders**

# **Evening Performances- 6:15 p.m. Matinee Performances- 12:15 p.m.**

#### **Check in procedure**

- Preschool and Kinders will be checked in and picked up IN THE FRONT LOBBY.
- Once in the lobby, students need to be fully dressed in costume (including shoes and accessories).
- Students can then be checked in by their adult at the check in table.
  - o If a student is being checked in by anyone other than a parent/guardian, that person's name and phone number must be provided upon check in.
  - We will assume the person signing in will also be signing out; please notify the CJ staff person at check in if this is not the case.
- Students will be escorted backstage and supervised by CJ volunteers.
- Students cannot bring anything with them backstage. They will be provided activities and monitored by CJ volunteers.

#### While they are performing

- Preschool and/or Kinders are the first act of each show.
- Parents/guardians will NOT be allowed to watch the performances UNLESS they have purchased a ticket.

#### Check out procedure

- Preschool and Kinder students are dismissed immediately after their act has finished performing (roughly 10 minutes after the show begins).
- Students will be escorted directly from their performance into the lobby.
- Parents/guardians must meet their student IN THE LOBBY and check them out with the CJ volunteer.
- Students may re-enter the arena as a spectator ONLY after being signed out and ONLY if they have a ticket.
