SUPER SESSION FAQ

Will classes cost more?

Prices are NOT increasing. You will be charged the same class rate that you were charged during Fall registration; however, the amount due will be doubled because you are paying for winter and spring session all at once. For example, Circus Kinders is a general fee class and costs \$230 per session. You will be charged \$460 during Super Session registration to cover winter and spring session costs.

The general fee discount still applies and the adjusted amounts will be published on the Class Costs page of the Super Session guide and on the Payment page of our website.

Is there the same payment plan?

A payment plan that matches our current standard payment will be available at checkout, so there is no need to change your budgeting plans!

If you enroll in the 2 part payment plan, 50% of your total balance will be charged at checkout, and the credit card used will be saved for future auto-billing on: Feb 16.

If you enroll in the 4 part payment plan, 25% of your total balance will be charged at checkout, and the credit card used will be saved for future auto-billing payment dates: Dec 15, Feb 2, March 8.

What if I can't take classes this spring?

Our guidance has always been for students to continue in the same classes from winter to spring sessions. It is necessary for classes performing in the Spring Celebration Performances to start working on their act as early as possible, and costumes must be purchased over the holidays in order for them to arrive in time for our spring shows. This is also why students are NOT able to join performing-level classes between winter and spring session.

Families who do not wish to continue classes during the spring portion of Super Session will have the opportunity to drop classes before the drop date deadline on **January**28. As always, winter tuition and costume fees are non-refundable after winter session starts, but there will be a drop process available for families who need to remove spring session fees.

When is the Spring Show?

That depends which show team you are on! Students will be told which color show team they are on at the Spring Celebration Performances **Family Meeting on February 24 4:00 - 6:00 p.m.** Can't make the meeting? The information packet and your show team assignment will also be emailed out after the meeting.

Conflicts?

Do you have conflicts with the Spring Show performance dates? We ask that families plan to be available for both weekends and pay careful attention to the dates for each show color. Spring can be a busy time of year, please communicate any unchangeable conflicts to adminstaff@circusjuventas.org by December 8. We do not guarantee that we are able to accommodate any conflicts with particular show colors, or sibling groupings. Any conflicts sent to us after December 8, 2023 will not be accommodated.

Extra Practices



Circus Juventas Presents: A Hygge Holiday



CLASS COSTS

How much does a class cost? That depends on the price category and and if a multi-class discount applies! Read on to learn about general fee, fixed fee, and the multi-class discount.

How To Pay:

- >> Pay in full at check out. The primary parent on the account is ultimately responsible for all payments on their student's account. Delayed payments can result in delay or refusal of student enrollment.
- >> Enroll in a 2 or 4 part payment plan.

If you enroll in the 2 part payment plan, 50% of your total balance will be charged at checkout, and the credit card used will be saved for future auto-billing on: Feb 16.

If you enroll in the 4 part payment plan, 25% of your total balance will be charged at checkout, and the credit card used will be saved for future auto-billing payment dates: Dec 15, Feb 2, March 8.

>> If you have a <u>credit</u> available on your account, you will have the option to first apply the credit to the balance due before paying the remaining balance at check out.

Other fees:

- >> \$45 non-refundable pre-registration fee (once per academic year). If you are returning from Fall Session, you have already completed this.
- >> \$25 late fee applied to returning student registrations submitted after the on-time registration deadline.
- >> \$115 Costume fees will automatically be applied to all classes performing in the spring shows. These are paid for during registration and are non-refundable once the session begins.

Program Overview

The two-year training program with our world-renowned coaching staff and laser focused, customized training curriculum allows our students to develop professional skills, prepare for original CJIPP productions, festivals and competitions, build dynamic act routines and network with professional organizations such as Cirque Du Soleil and other notable professional circus companies.

Under the direction of Sun Yanhong and Rob Dawson, Pro Program students will focus in chosen disciplines and integrated cross-training. Students will also have training in physical and mental wellness from our partners at Health Partners TRIA in topics such as nutrition, sports psychology, core and back stability, etc.

Our International Pro Program students had the opportunity to perform in front of numerous audiences both inside and outside the CJ big top. They performed across the Midwest with our original production of "Fools Gold". These students also competed in VIVA Fest in 2023 with great success! The Circus Juventas partnership with Cirque Du Soleil NexGen gives our pro students the opportunity to learn from and be seen by CDS coaches and choreographers throughout the year.

Colors: Each act is marked to denote the level of pre-requisites needed for the FIRST lovel of that act

GREEN classes require no additional class pre-requisites other than meeting the age requirement. New to our program? Start here!

ORANGE classes are beginning-level classes that require a skill/class building prerequisite. These acts usually require participating in a non-performing class or the first level of an act to gain the experience necessary to move up.

PINK classes require previous experience to begin training in the act. Look carefully at the prerequisites listed to determine your eligibility.

AQUA classes require an ADVANCED level of training even for the lowest level. These classes are often marked as "invitation only."

WHITE invitation-only classes are advanced classes which have very specific skill requirements. Depending on the class, this could include base/flyer experience, partner experience/match-up, emotional maturity, performance experience, size, experience with a specific apparatus, etc. As such, coaches need to have experience with or evaluate students prior to invitation into a class. If you feel that your student is eligible for an invitation-only class to which they have not received a recommendation, or to express interest in these classes in the future, please contact adminstaff@circusjuventas.org.

Letters:


Each act has an ACT CODE that begins with letters. These letters stand for the name of the act. For example, "SS" stands for Side by Side.

Numbers:

Each class has two sets of numbers separated by a hyphen. The numbers before the hyphen are the LEVEL of the class. They numbers after the hyphen are the class SECTION.

Registration Tip!

Sections are associated with a specific day and time. We have many popular classes with multiple sections within a week. When registering for a class with multiple sections, use different sections as alternate classes as a way to indicate order of preference in the event your requested class is full.



Act Code Example

The letters in this act code stand for "German" Wheel," German Wheel is an act with four different levels. This is the lowest level of the act, as denoted by the "0000" before the hyphen. This class is very popular and three different sections are offered. The example class code is for section 1, which we know from the numbers "01" after the hyphen.






